



Date Joined Pension: The date you began contributing to the scheme, this may not be the same as your pensionable start date if you had prior temporary service that was not pensionable at the time but has since been recognised as pensionable

Retirement Date: Currently set to your 65th birthday. Note the compulsory retirement age for members joining the public sector prior to 01/04/2004 is now 70 years. Those joining post 2004 to 31/12/2012 have no compulsory retirement age.




Benefits

Pension: The annual pension amount payable at retirement

Lump Sum: The lump sum amount payable at retirement

Death in Service Spouse/Civil Partner/Child Pension: The annual pension amount payable on date of death to a spouse/civil partner or dependant

Death in Service Lump Sum: The greater of the lump sum based on pensionable service and earnings at date of death or one years salary, payable to the Spouse/Civil Partner/Legal&Personal Representatives




For additional detail on your service years select the magnifier tool

Full Time or Part Time Pre or Post 01/01/2011: UCD full time or part time service accrued pre or post 01/01/2011

Transfer/Bought Back: Previous public sector service that has been transferred into the UCD pension scheme or bought back

Accrued Notional Service (Gross): Purchased notional service years

Accrued Notional (Free) (Gross): Discretionary added service years that are not guaranteed. This service will not be shown on your record.



Retirement Options

Select the relevant Benefit Statement as follows and click Generate Benefits:

Early Retirement: Payable from age 60 to 65 years for members who commenced public sector employment in a pensionable capacity prior to 01/04/2004

Actuarially Reduced Early Retirement: Payable from 50 to 59 years - or from 55 to 64 years for members who commenced public sector employment in a pensionable capacity post 01/04/2004

Normal Retirement: Payable from 65 years

Deferred Benefits: Leavers from UCD with 2 years service will be entitled to the benefits on reaching retirement age

Death in Service Benefits: Payable in the event of death to spouse/civil partner/children/legal representatives



Current Amounts: Your Pension, Lump Sum, Spouse & Child Pensions based on the calculation criteria entered. For additional detail on any of these amounts select the relevant magnifier tool
