Description of SAPS record layout

1. GENERAL:

Copyright in the Small Area Population Statistics (SAPS) is vested in the Government of Ireland. SAPS files are normally for the sole use of the person or organisation to whom they have been supplied by the Central Statistics Office. They may not be passed on to any third party, except with the written agreement of the Central Statistics Office and subject to any additional conditions and charges laid down by the Central Statistics Office in such an agreement. They may not be used to develop or derive any data product or service without a licence to do so.

A special SAPS request for data on diskette for a special SAPS Job involves transmission of the following files:

1. Read_2002.doc: This contains a description of the data.
2. There are 6 comma delimited ASCII files for each special SAPS Job which contain the full details as follows:

A request for more than one special SAPS Job involves a single copy of Read_2002.doc and separate data files for each Job Number.

The files are easily importable into software packages such as Lotus 123 and Microsoft Excel.

In Lotus 123 use the commands: File, Import from, Numbers.

In Microsoft Excel use: File, Open and the following steps from the Text Import Wizard:

File type: Delimited
Delimiter: Comma
Column data format: General

2. SAPS general layout

The first line in each file contains the column titles for each column of data. A list of abbreviations used in the column titles is given at appendix 1.

For all other lines of each file, the layout is as follows:

The first variable in each line is the census year. The second variable in each line is the type of record (see below). The third variable gives the identification details. The fourth variable is the name of the geographic area. The various counts start from there. The records are in the same order from one file to the next for each special SAPS Job, i.e. record 2 on SPC_C02_1.CSV refers to the same geographic area as record 2 on SPC_C02_2.CSV etc.

3. AREA TYPE CODES

Type 1 is the accumulated count of all records for a county

Type 2 is the accumulated count of Gaeltacht records for a county

Type 3 is the accumulated count for a Town within a county

Type 4 is the accumulated count for an Urban or Rural Area (formerly UD/RD) within a county

Type 6 is the accumulated count for an ED (formerly DED) within a Urban/Rural Area

Type A is the accumulated count for the Aggregate Rural Area within a county

Type B is the accumulated count for the Aggregate Town Area within a county

Type C is the accumulated count for legally defined towns or their environs within a county

Type F is the accumulated count for a Local Electoral Area (formerly County/Borough Electoral Area)

Type G is the accumulated count for a full Constituency

5. Coverage of the Census

The census figures relate to the de facto population, i.e. the population recorded for each area represents the total of all persons present within its boundaries on the night of Sunday, 28 April 2002, together with all persons who arrived in that area on the morning of Monday, 29 April 2002, not having been enumerated elsewhere. Persons on board ships in port are included with the population of adjacent areas. The figures, therefore, include visitors present on census night as well as those in residence, while usual residents temporarily absent from the area are excluded from the census count.

A limited number of questions, relating mainly to demographic characteristics, were asked in respect of usual residents who were temporarily absent from their households on census night. The responses to these questions enables a more precise picture to be built up on families and households by excluding visitors present on census night and including residents who were temporarily absent.

A private household comprises either one person living alone or a group of people (not necessarily related) living at the same address with common housekeeping arrangements - that is, sharing at least one meal a day or sharing a living room or sitting room. In order to be included in the household, a person must be a usual resident at the time of the census. Therefore, visitors to the household on census night are excluded, while usual residents temporarily absent (for less than 3 months) are included.
