## 01 Attend Orientation - Wednesday 3 to Friday 5 September

Make sure you check your Orientation timetable carefully to see what day(s) you'll be on campus for Orientation.

## 02 Meet your Peer Mentor

You will be assigned to a Peer Mentor who is a student from your degree. They'll contact you before you arrive on campus, show you around during orientation and keep in touch during your first term.

## 03 Find your way around campus

Google Maps is the best way to find your way around campus. All the main buildings are clearly labeled. This [Orientation campus map](#) is also very useful.

## 04 Start Step 2 of registration from 4 September (depending on your start time).

Check your UCD email for your start time.

## 05 Check your Academic Timetable in SISWeb

Important information on module content and assessments is presented at the first lecture of each module - don't miss it!

## 06 Know where to go for support

There is much to enjoy at university, but if you do have any problems there are people to help you.

## 07 Get to know your Student's Union

The SU represents students' views and opinions, and works on a number of University committees as the voice of the student population.

## 08 Get involved in UCD life

Get involved during Freshers' Week (15 – 19 September) and Sports Expo (15 – 18 September).

## 09 Finalise your module choices - by 5pm Friday, 19 September

Make sure you have registered to enough credits (60 credits) and that you have registered to any labs and tutorials
