From Friday, 29 August, you can begin Step 1 of registration (or within three working days of accepting your offer).

During Step 1 of registration:

- You'll confirm your registration for the academic year, upload a photo for your student card and confirm your personal details.
- You don't register for individual modules at this stage you'll do this in Step 2 (module registration) of registration. We'll send you an email telling you when to start Step 2.
