What the training involves

You must complete a theory **and** practical module in order to comply with the guidelines set out in the policy above.

Part 1 theory module

The Manual Handling and People Handling e-learning [theory module](#) is mandatory for all students. The theory module must be completed on [HSELand](#). It has two parts, a learning module & an assessment module. You must complete both in order to gain your eLearning certificate & part 1 must be completed in order to gain access to part 2.

Part 2 practical module

The practical module is an opportunity to transfer the knowledge gained from the theory module into practice. In order to register for the practical session you should complete the form, using the link below & upload your HSELand theory module certificate as evidence of completion.
