Advocate, develop an evidence base, explore phased approaches or small pilots.

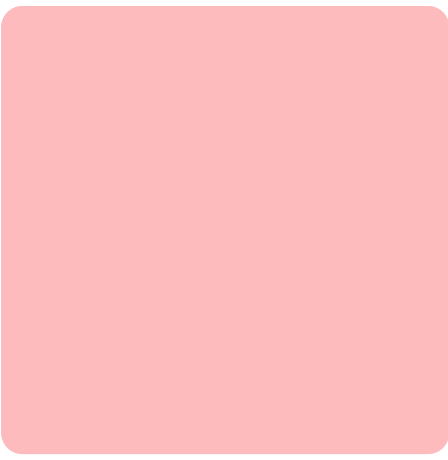
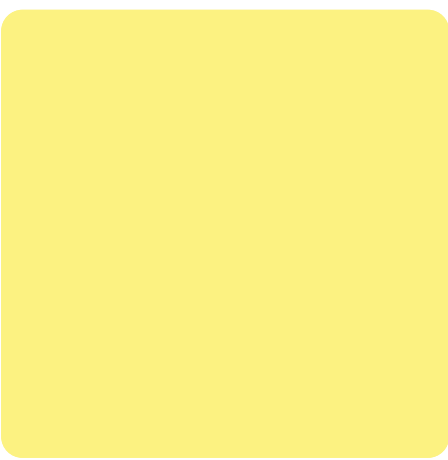
This work is crucial and already happening, but it's difficult to make visible or formalise.
Systemic barriers (funding, policy, recognition) prevent this from being widely accepted.
How can we build an argument for recognition? What reporting/data is needed?

High Impact and High Feasability

Prioritise, develop tools or reporting, embed into systems.

We already do this, and it's feasible to document, scale, or formalise.
This impact is recognised, but we could enhance visibility with reporting or tools.
We have resources to translate this into meaningful reporting or practice change.

Park, pivot, reconsider

Are we trying to document something that doesn't need formalisation?
Would investing in this take away from more impactful work?"

Low Impact, High Feasibility

Only pursue if it strengthens other high-impact efforts

This is easy to formalize, but does it add meaningful impact?
Would this work better as a supportive tool for high-impact activities?
Can it be bundled with other initiatives for a bigger impact?
