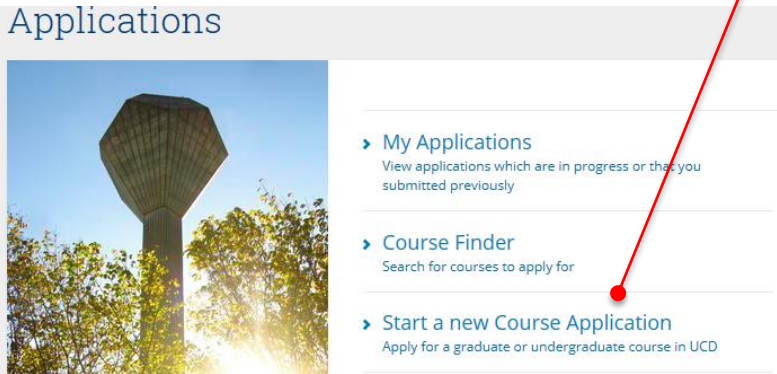


- To apply for your CPD course, click on this link www.ucd.ie/apply. This will take you to the UCD applications web page. Click on **'Start a new Course Application'**.



- Select **'Create a New Account'** or **'Use an existing account'** if you were a student in UCD previously.

Create a new Account

Creating a new account is easy. You will be asked simply for your name and security question.

! Creating a new account will automatically trigger an email from UCD to that address so make sure the email address is one you use regularly. Check your mailbox and continue with the steps below.

- When you click **Continue**, you will be taken to the online application form. Check your personal details and then click on **Select a Course**. Enter the code for your hospital or organisation: Major code: **X639** and press **Enter**.

9. Read the **Declaration** and click **Submit**.

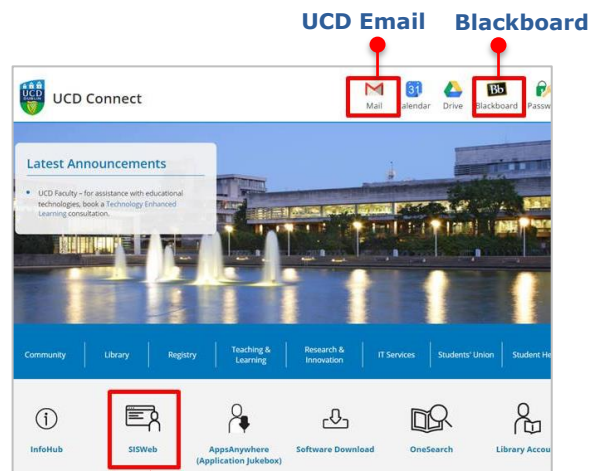
! You must complete all of the steps in this information sheet. Otherwise, we will not be able to register you to your module and you will not be able to access your results.

What happens next?

1. You will receive an email from UCD Admissions confirming your **UCD Application**. Your application will be processed within one week and the CPD Administrator in UCD will issue you with an offer.
2. You will then receive an email from UCD Admissions confirming '**Application status change**'. Upon receipt of this email, log back into your applications account and **Accept your offer**.
3. You will receive a third email from UCD Admissions confirming your '**UCD Acceptance**' - this email will include your UCD Student Number and your UCD email account (name.surname@ucdconnect.ie) will be activated.

Please ignore any additional requirements mentioned in the automatic emails such as Application Fee, Previous 3rd level attendance, English Language Requirements, Supporting documentation as these do not apply to CPD students.

UCD student information systems and email
[UCD Connect](http://www.ucd.ie/connect) provides access to UCD Email, Blackboard, SISWeb (the student records system) and Google Drive. Once you become a registered student you will have access to all of these and it is UCD policy to use your UCD email address for all official communication. To access UCD email, go to www.ucd.ie/connect and click on the **Mail** icon. Enter your student number and password.
