Programme Overview

"How can a One Health approach improve our pandemic preparedness?"

Our experience of COVID over the last 2 years has proven that we are incredibly vulnerable to infectious diseases, despite all the medical advancements that have been made. To combat another pandemic of similar scale or even to counteract localised epidemics, it is vital to approach infectious disease management with a holistic, One Health mindset.

Multiple factors influence the emergence of infectious diseases including levels of understanding about infectious diseases, economic status of populations, political stability, animal interactions, environmental stability, scientific knowledge, climate change and human behaviour. Once a virus starts to spread, how that virus is subsequently controlled or managed is also determined by several factors such as the health services within a country, the wealth of the country, the political will, the scientific ability to monitor and understand the virus.

This summer school will focus on exploring different factors that influence both the emergence or re-emergence of viruses with pandemic potential. We will draw on multiple areas of expertise to analyse how different countries responded to this pandemic and identify key factors that will provide the world with better tools to handle the next one.
