The organization of healthcare for people with intellectual disabilities (ID) differs internationally and each country has developed unique and innovative practices to give shape to this healthcare. Understanding how healthcare for people with ID is organized across countries allows for collaboration and knowledge exchange between healthcare professionals, researchers, and policymakers at an international level, facilitating the development of more inclusive healthcare systems worldwide. This webinar presents an overview of the organisation of healthcare in the United Kingdom and Zambia, along with findings from a synthesis of the organisation of healthcare in 13 international jurisdictions and concludes with a panel discussion. This webinar showcases some of the submissions to a Special Edition on this topic that is due for publication in late 2023 in the Journal of Policy and Practice in Intellectual Disabilities.
