From **Monday, 8 September** changes to major structures will require approval by your Governing Board on a <u>Structure Change Proposal Form</u> (PDARF16).

Requests to update Careers & Skills Statements, Vision/Values & Programme Outcomes for 2025/26 September-intake majors should be submitted to curriculum@ucd.ie on an approved Proposal Form (PDARF7).

- strategies impact how your module appears on Grade Entry and may lead to its exclusion from end-of-trimester exam scheduling (if applicable).
- The Approaches to Teaching & Learning field in the Content/Learning Outcomes section is updated to indicate whether / to what extent AI may be used.
- Details of the staff/faculty associated with the module on <u>Module Access Management</u> are reviewed in compliance with GDPR so that only colleagues with a current requirement to view student information have this access.
- All other mandatory information is complete and anomalies highlighted on the <u>Modules Missing Data</u> report are addressed.
