Registration Key Dates

- Module Registration will follow the same pattern and start time groups as last year with minor changes.
- Registration starts Wednesday, 13 August 2025.
- Elective Allocation Monday, 1 September 2025.
- Registration will close on Friday, 19 September 2025.
- All dates published on <u>Student Key Dates</u>





Stage 1 Undergraduate Key Dates

- Stage 1 Students will register to modules on 4 and 5 September 2025 and will start term on 8 September with continuing students.
- Students that did not progress from Stage 1 will register with incoming cohort.
- Graduate Entry Med/Vet/Radiography will register on 4/5 September 2025.
- Programmes with significant choice at Stage 1 will be prioritised to register on 4 September 2025 due to the tight timeline.

Can not request a chat with a human – directed to use another support pathway

Continuous monitoring of website for latest answers

Best for general information (such as info found online), not for specific queries on students records

Recently upgraded to AI version - answers taken from UCD website






Logging Interactions

- Every interaction (via phone, email, or face to face) is logged on Unishare as it ensures we have a complete history of what we've helped a student with.
- If we ask a student to contact another area, the quick task "Referred to..." is used along with a supporting comment if needed.
- •All Colleges/School offices have a "referred to Student Desk" button, which we encourage people to use if they ask a student to contact us.




 Support peer mentors, provide student voice to the peer mentoring committee, design Instagram comms and updates, working with myUCD creating TikTok content
