#### Dear Colleague,

This email is further to the Registrar's recent communication about Covid-19 related changes to on-campus activity in the Spring Trimester. In light of this, the <u>Review my Module Teaching Arrangements</u> menu on InfoHub is now open and will be available until 5pm on Tuesday, 19 January 2021 to facilitate necessary changes.

#### **Actions Required**

- Module Coordinators with essential on-campus teaching should determine in conjunction with their Head of School whether this teaching can continue as planned or if it should be postponed or moved to a remote format.
- If on-campus teaching is moving to a remote format (temporarily or permanently), the relevant Course Reference Numbers (CRNs) must be amended on the <u>Review my Module Teaching</u> <u>Arrangements</u> menu.
- Changes should be communicated to students as soon as possible.

#### Reporting

- School-level reporting is available on the Teaching Arrangements Report by School.
- The <u>Module Timetable Search</u> displays the teaching arrangements for individual CRNs. This information is visible to students via SISWeb and their Google calendar.
