Dear Colleague,

Just to update you on some recent decisions impacting on planned delivery of assessments in UCD.

As you will appreciate, the worsening health situation in Ireland means we are currently making rapid adjustments to the assessments, particularly those planned to be delivered inperson. The UCD Academic Council has authorised that changes can be made now, where appropriate, to deliver alternative online assessments. These can be provided both at the end-trimester exam session (replacing a planned in-person exam) and also an additional session in January. This is to support students by providing a suitable alternative that will not unduly delay their progress if impacted over these next few weeks by COVID related circumstances. Clearly, there is very limited time for the usual review and engagement many colleagues would prefer to organise with you as Subject Extern Examiner. Therefore, your contacts in the Schools here will make these available in the usual way where appropriate and if this is feasible or for information at a later stage. In all cases, there is also no expectation that you would be able to respond in the usual way either and I appreciate that you may well be dealing with similar issues in your own institution.

We thank you as always for your support and assistance and particularly through these exceptional circumstances that we continue to find ourselves in.
