Just ahead of the commencement of the examinations, some final reminders to assist you:

General reminder:

- Check your exam timetable to make sure you know where and when your exam is taking place.
- There are three in-person exam venues; RDS Shelbourne, the Newman Building and the Blackrock Exam Hall. (Note: For the Newman Building report to A105 and your room will be allocated to you).
- Familiarise yourself with UCD's Examination Regulations.
- Support is available to you if you are feeling distressed.
- Past Exam Question Papers are available through SISWeb.

For Online Exams:

- In advance of your exams, know who to contact and how to contact them in case you encounter difficulties.
- Review information on getting ready, setting up, and taking your online exam.
- Prepare your browser/device. Details on how to do this are available on the UCD IT Services website.

For In-Person Exams:

- Know where you are going and how to get to your exam. Check the Student Assessment website for directions to the Exam Centres.
- Remember to bring writing implements and your UCARD. The use or attempted use of any electronic device that holds, receives or transmits data including but not necessarily limited to mobile phones and smart watches (unless the use of this device is specifically confirmed by UCD Access and Lifelong Learning through a Needs Assessment prior to the exams) is strictly prohibited during an examination or in the examination hall and is a serious breach of discipline.
- Prior to the exam, check your seat number provided on your SISWeb account for quick access to the exam hall. If you do not have a seat number, ask an Exam Helper (in orange t-shirts) on arrival who will direct you to a seat.
- Exam Helpers and Invigilators are there to help you, follow their advice and directions. Ask them for help if you need it.
- Due to the ventilation levels required in the halls, windows and doors may need to be opened at various times, therefore we suggest that you wear layers of clothing.
- Have any items that you want to leave in the cloakroom ready to hand over to staff before you reach the cloakroom. There is no fee required for the cloakroom. Bags are not allowed in the exam hall and must be left in the cloakroom.

• Don't attend an in-person exam if you are displaying COVID-19 symptoms or other infectious illness symptoms. See the HSE website on self-isolation and information on the extenuating circumstances process.

If exams have to be postponed for an exceptional reason such as for a power outage or adverse weather conditions, there is a contingency plan in place and you will be notified to your UCD connect email address.

Stage 1 Undergraduates start on 06 January 2023 (depending on start time). All other students start on 13 or 16 January 2023 (depending on College/Stage).
