- to deepen links between UCD postdocs

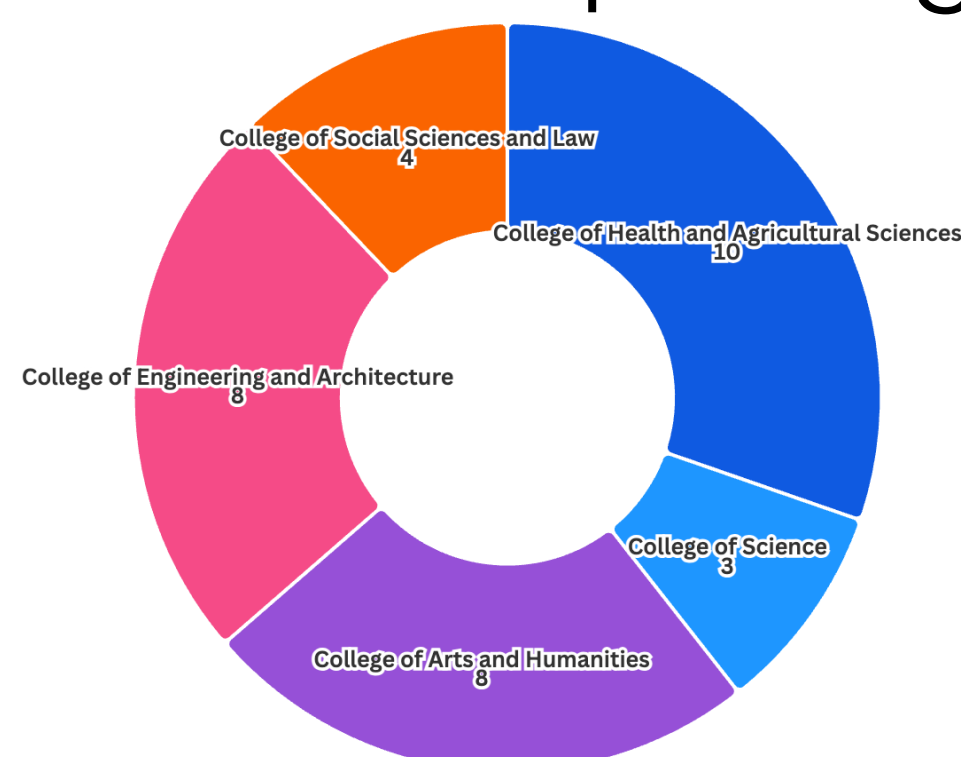
## Method





# THE INTRODUCTION

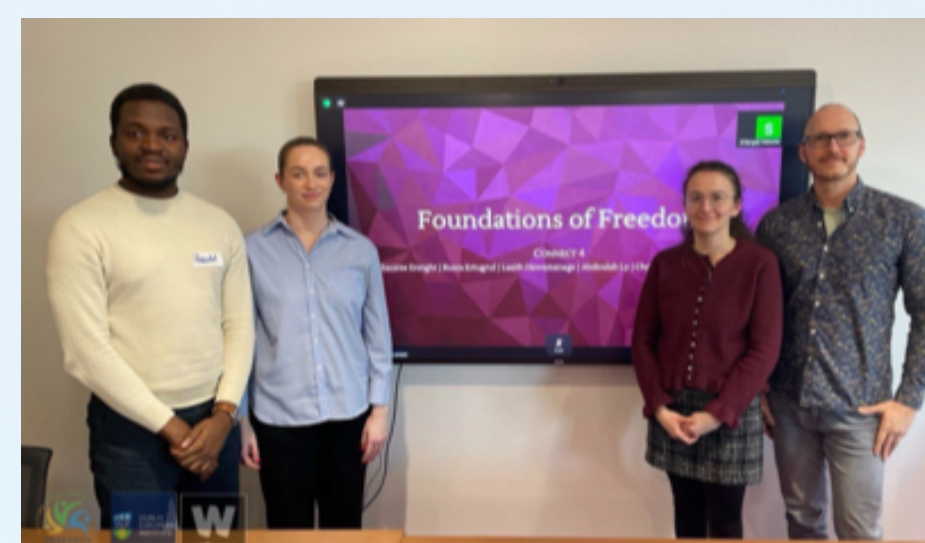
- Participants in curated radically interdisciplinary groups
