

Student Appeals Process

The following appeals can be made by students under this procedure

Assessment Appeals:

- An appeal against the result of any assessment of students' academic work
- decisions of the Academic Council Committee on Examinations on the award of a Research Master's Degree.
- decisions on progression in and award of doctoral programmes. A student can appeal the decision of the Transfer Assessment Panel or the decision of the Academic Council Committee on Examinations on the award.

Student Conduct Appeals:

- decisions made under the Student Discipline Procedure
- decisions of School Plagiarism Committees.
- decisions by UCD Residences in relation to breaches of the License to Reside.

Continuation, Progression and Standing Appeals:

- decisions made by Governing Boards in respect of: Discontinuation of a student's registration under Continuation (Academic Regulation); Fitness to Continue in Study; Student Fitness to Practise
- decisions of the Ad Astra Academy to discontinue a scholarship.
- decisions made by the Student Vetting Committee.
- decisions made by the Risk Assessment Standing Committee.
