In the Autumn trimester 2020 our modules are being delivered in a variety of formats: sometimes you will have a choice of either a face-to-face class on campus or an online class, while other times the class will be online only. Online classes will usually be held at the time-tabled hours in the virtual classroom, but some lecture-style classes will be pre-recorded. Students who are unable to attend campus for reasons of health or other COVID-related circumstances and are thus unable to attend the face-to-face class they have registered to, may attend the online option when available. If not available, these students will be facilitated, and all the relevant material will naturally be available online.
