Entry Requirements

- **Primary degree (NFQ Level 8)** in one or more languages, with an overall award of at least Second Class Honours, Grade 1.
- **Two references** from academic referees willing to comment on their intellectual ability, maturity and motivation.
- Applicants whose first language is not English must also demonstrate **English language proficiency** of IELTS 7.0 (with no band less than 6.5 in each element).
