

A photography competition for UCD students (present and alumni) about the values of the <u>UCD School of Social Policy</u>, <u>Social Work and Social Justice</u>. The topic for the competition is open. This could be about students' lives at UCD, nature, people, architecture, etc. We encourage creative and original photos.

## **Terms and Conditions:**

- 1. The competition is open to current UCD students and UCD alumni.
- 2. Closing date: Thursday, 30 April 2020.
- 3. No more than three photographs can be entered by the same person.
- 4. Entries must be made in the following way:
  - a. post your photo(s) to the UCD School of Social Policy, Social Work and Social Justice <u>facebook page</u> (<a href="https://www.facebook.com/UCDSocialPWJ">https://www.facebook.com/UCDSocialPWJ</a>); **AND**
  - b. twitter @UCDSocialPWJ; AND
  - c. email a high-resolution copy of the photo to UCDSocialPWJ.Photo@ucd.ie
- 5. Photos must be submitted from you **UCD email account.** Don't submit via a personal email account.
- 6. A committee will select three (03) winners:
  - a. First winner €350
  - b. Second winner €100
  - c. Third winner €50
- 7. The Committee's decision is final and binding in all matters and no correspondence will be entered.
- 8. The promoter is excluded from liability for any loss, damage or injury which might occur to the winner arising from his or her acceptance of the prize.
- 9. Photographers may make reasonable use of digital darkroom type techniques which enhance quality but do not distort the photograph. Only minor burning, dodging and/or colour correction is acceptable, as is cropping. High dynamic range images (HDR) and stitched panoramas are NOT acceptable. Any changes to the original Photograph not itemized here are unacceptable and will render the Photograph ineligible for a prize the open, and source categories are exempt from this rule.
- 10. All imagery MUST be the total and exclusive work of the submitting photographer and may not include any element that is the copyright of another.
- 11. Entry to the competition shall be deemed full and unconditional acceptance of the terms and conditions.
- 12. The UCD School of Social Policy, Social Work and Social Justice reserves the right to amend these terms and conditions.
- 13. When a photograph is submitted, and entry finalised the entry cannot be changed or edited.
- 14. The UCD School of Social Policy, Social Work and Social Justice reserves the right to disqualify from the competition any entrant suspected of engaging in plagiarism, cheating or unfair activity.
- 15. By entering the competition and submitting your photograph, you hereby grant the UCD School of Social Policy, Social Work and Social Justice a license to use your photograph in print publications and online for the promotion of the School and its activities.
