Approved Roles for Garda Vetting in the Leisure, Health and Fitness Sector as approved by the Garda National Vetting Bureau in compliance with The National Vetting Bureau (Children and Vulnerable Persons) Acts 2012 to 2016 which outlines the definition of **Relevant Work or Activities** relating to Children or Vulnerable Persons.

Please see below the roles that we can now vet, each which involve the undertaking of relevant work or activities with children and/or vulnerable persons as defined by the Acts.
