#### Online Registration

To access online registration, log into [SISWeb](#) and click on **My Registration**. You can also access it using the **Registration, Fees & Assessment** tab in the top bar of [SISWeb](#).

**Undergraduate\* and Graduate Taught students** - check your UCD Connect email for confirmation of your Start Time for module registration. Your Start Time is open-ended so you can begin your registration any time from the date/time confirmed in the email.

*\*If you missed your chance to book your Start Time, don't worry. One will be allocated to you and confirmation sent to your UCD email.*

Online registration for **Graduate Research students** opens on 15 August 2019.

All students must go online to confirm their registration to their programme. To do this, log into [SISWeb](#) and click on **My Registration**. [This quick video shows you how.](#)
