If you need to make **changes to Semester 2 module registrations**, you should by 5.00pm on Tuesday, 29 January 2019.

Repeat/Resit Registration

Provisional exam results will be available on [SISWeb](#) **between 2.00pm on Wednesday, 23 January and 5.00pm on Tuesday, 29 January 2019**. If you have failed any modules from Semester 1, please check the [resits and repeats](#) information on the UCD website.

Undergraduate and Graduate Taught students, between 2.00pm on 24 January and 5.00pm on 29 January 2019, you will be able to **register to any repeats/resits through the Repeats/Subs/Tran** page in Online Registration. If you have modules with WL or WX grades, you will be able to register to a next attempt for those as well.

View your Student Record (UView)

UView allows you to check information such as your Programme history, contact information, module registration, GPA and grades.

You can view your student record in [SISWeb](#) at any point. Do this by logging into log SISWeb using your UCD student number and password. Click on the Registration, Fees & Assessment tab and select UView in the menu list.

UCD Academic Regulations

New Academic Regulations will be in place for September 2019; however they may affect the choices you make for Semester 2 of 2018/19.

From the academic year 2019/20 onwards you will be able to progress carrying 10 credits from the **immediately preceding Stage only**. This means that all other Stages must be completed in full before you progress. For example, if you are in Stage 2 in 2018/2019, you must have fully completed Stage 1 and be carrying no more than 10 credits from Stage 2 to progress to Stage 3 in 2019/2020.

From the academic year 2019/20, resits will count towards your credit limit. You will be limited to a **maximum of 40 credits in a semester**,

including resits.

Campus Car Parking Semester 2

Permit Parking Annual Fee

If you have paid the annual permit parking fee please check that you have your correct car licence plate number recorded on your [parking permit account](#).

Permit Parking Semester 2 Fee

If you only paid for Semester 1 and wish to use permit parking in Semester 2 (21 January – 26 April 2019) you must log on to your [parking permit account](#) and pay the fee due. Please ensure that your permit parking fee is paid before parking on campus during this period and that your correct car licence plate number is registered for your parking permit. No permit is required for Semester 3.

To apply for a permit parking account go to www.ucd.ie/commuting and choose Parking in UCD from the top menu and then Parking Permit – Apply option. Follow the instructions to complete and pay for your permit.
