Please note

The Fee Hold will affect access to your examination results and you will be unable to graduate, if completing your programme.

What you need to know

- If you have outstanding fees you will not be able to see your results when they are released on 18 June.
- When you pay your fees the hold does not lift straight away. This is an overnight process, so please allow for this when making payments.
- Continuing full-time, undergraduate degree students may carry a maximum debt of €600 from one academic year to the next and still be able to access final results and register for the new academic year.

What you need to do

- Log into [SISWeb](#) and click on Registration, Fees & Assessment
- Go to Programme Fees & Payments to check what fees you owe

- You can then pay online using a debit/credit card – online payments clear straight away. There are other payment options available – go to www.ucd.ie/fees and click on How to pay for details

Please make sure to include your student number on any payment made to the University.
