The final confirmed Autumn Trimester Exam Timetable is now available on the [UCD Current Students website](#). An individualised Exam Timetable will be available shortly on your UCD Connect Account on [SISWeb](#).

Exam Venues

There are five types of venues that will appear on the timetable:

- RDS - (In-person) your exam takes place in the RDS, Shelbourne Hall, the start time and duration is displayed on your individualised timetable.
- Blackrock - (In-person) your exam takes place in the Blackrock Exam Centre, the start time and duration is displayed on your individualised timetable.
- Online - your exam takes place online. Your exam has been allocated a time slot however, the specific details of the exam will be provided by your Module Coordinator, i.e. start time, exam duration, finish time and any additional time allowed to download/upload/submit the exam.
- Classroom - (may be in-person or online) your exam takes place in a classroom setting. The specific details of the exam will be provided by your Module Coordinator, i.e. location, start time and exam duration.
- Newman Centre - (In-person) students registered with disability / temporary support will sit their exams in the Newman Examination Centre in the Newman building on the Belfield campus. On your individualised exam timetable, the venue will be listed as A106, Newman Office / Reception. You will receive an email with further details on individual rooms for each exam in late November.

Assessments not scheduled

There may be some assessments due to take place during the Autumn exam period that are not scheduled. If you have a query relating to a module that does not appear on the Exam Timetable and you have not been informed by your Module Coordinator that it is a take home assessment, classroom held exam or you see an exam clash in your timetable you should contact your School as a matter of urgency.

General guidance and COVID-19

For in-person exams, we will continue to be led by Public Health recommendations to minimise the opportunity for COVID-19 to spread, therefore additional measures will be in

place to maximise your safety and the safety of the staff. It is important that all requirements are met and advice is followed in order to ensure entry in the exam halls and to avoid any disruption to your exams. Updated information will be available along with general guidance on preparing and taking exams and FAQs on the [Exam pages](#) of the Current Students website. Ensure to check this website regularly and a reminder of all the important messages will be sent to you ahead of the exams.
