#### **UCD Connect**

The information below will explain how to access online services such as email and online registration through UCD Connect.

#### What is UCD Connect?

<u>UCD Connect</u> provides access to online services such as your official UCD student email account and Google calendar. You can also access online registration, via the SISWeb icon, where you must confirm your registration for the academic year. Your UCD Connect account will be available at least 48 hours in advance of you starting online registration.

You will need to use your student **UCD Connect username and password** to access the services available.

If you have any queries about your UCD Connect email account please contact <a href="IT">IT</a> Support Hub for assistance.

#### What is my student UCD Connect username and password?

- Your username is your UCD student number (see above)
- Your password:
  - If you created an Online Applications password during the application process, please use that.
  - If you have not logged into SISWeb (or Online Applications) before, your temporary password is your date of birth (in the format

ddmmyy).

You need to change this temporary password after a successful login, using <u>UCD Password Self Service</u>. **Please do this at first login**.

 If you already have a student UCD Connect account, please use those login details.

#### How do I access my UCD Connect student email account?

Your personalised UCD Connect email address will be used for official UCD correspondence so please make sure that you check it regularly.

- To access your UCD Connect email account, go to www.ucd.ie/connect
- Click on the Mail icon and choose Student(@ucdconnect.ie).
- Enter your student **UCD Connect username and password**.

#### How do I confirm my Registration?

- To access **online registration**, go to <u>www.ucd.ie/connect</u> and click on the **SISWeb** icon.
- Click on the **Log in via SSO** button and enter your student **UCD Connect** username (your student number) and password.
- When you first log into SISWeb you will need to read and accept the <u>University's Terms and Conditions</u>.
  This includes the UCD Student Health Declaration.
- Click on the **My Registration** button to **confirm your registration** for 2021/22 and begin online registration.
- If you need to choose a module online, you can do so via SISWeb from 2 pm on Tuesday 11 January 2022 to 5 pm on Friday, 04 February 2022.
