Complete your Registration

Your registration is your responsibility. It is very important that you get it right to ensure that you have access to your modules in Brightspace and that your timetable is correct.

Online registration will close at 5 pm on Friday, 29 September 2023* so make sure that you have confirmed your registration by that date. The Privacy & Security screen on the My Registration page in SISWeb will show if you have confirmed registration. *Online registration closes at 5 pm on Friday, 22 September for students in Graduate Entry Programmes.

Make sure you <u>register to enough credits</u> (including repeats/resits if needed) and **drop any extra modules** you are not planning to take. If you are a Full-Time Undergraduate, the 'Free Fees' scheme will only cover you for the standard amount of credits (normally 60 credits per stage).

Things to note

- After Friday, 29 September,* ask your <u>College or School Office</u> to make any changes to Autumn Trimester modules. *This will be Friday, 22 September for Graduate Entry Programmes.
- If you drop an Autumn Trimester module after Friday, 03 November 2023, you will have to pay fees for that module.
- You will have an opportunity in January 2024 to review your Spring Trimester modules and choose an Elective module if required. Keep an eye on the key dates page for updates.

View your student record (UView)

UView allows you to check information such as your Programme history, contact information, module registration, GPA and grades.

You can view your student record in SISWeb at any point. Do this by logging into SISWeb using your UCD student number and password. Click on the Registration, Fees & Assessment tab and select UView in the menu list.

Paying Your Fees

Check the <u>fee payment dates and what you need to pay</u> for 2023/24. The first fee payment deadline was Sunday, 17 September 2023. Watch the <u>Quick Guide to Fees</u> video.

Online payments can be made through your <u>SISWeb</u> account. <u>Other payment options</u> are also available.

Fees for **undergraduate students** will be charged on a modular basis. This means that as you select or drop modules, your fee charges will change accordingly. Check your fee account on a regular basis to ensure that you have met your fee payment requirements.

Emails from UCD
