Online Registration

Online registration opens **from 17 August** onwards. You will be **allocated a Registration Start Time** and the details sent to your UCD Connect email.

Your Start Time is open-ended so you can begin your registration any time from the date/time confirmed in the email.

All students must go online to **confirm their registration** to their programme. To do this, log into [SISWeb](#) using the **Log in with UCD Connect** button. Then click on **My Registration**.
