Complete your Registration

Your registration is your responsibility. It is very important that you get it right to ensure that you have access to your modules in Brightspace and that your timetable is correct.

To access **online registration**, go to <u>www.ucd.ie/connect</u> and click on the **SISWeb** icon.

- Enter your student **UCD Connect username and password**.
- Click on the **My Registration** button to **confirm your registration** for 2021/22 and begin online registration.
- Please confirm your registration by Monday, 31 January 2022

If you need to register to modules online, you can do this via SISWeb between Tuesday, 11 January and Friday, 04 February 2022. Check the key dates page for details.

Pay Your Fees

Check the <u>fee payment dates and what you need to pay</u> for 2021/22. The first fee payment deadline will be 31 January 2022.

You can make payments of up to 1,500 euros per transaction via your <u>SISWeb</u> account. To make a payment and view your fees balance, **log in to SISWeb**, **go to Registration**, **Fees and Assessment and then Programme Fees and Payments**. Other payment options are also available.

Reactivate/Get a Student Card (UCARD)

Your UCARD is your official identification card for the duration of your programme in UCD.

If you are a continuing student, once you have confirmed registration for the current academic year, your student card will be valid for 2021/22.

If you need a new student card, contact the UCARD Bureau.

View your student record (UView)

UView allows you to check information such as your Programme history, contact information, module registration, GPA and grades.

You can view your student record in SISWeb at any point. Do this by logging into SISWeb using your UCD student number and password. Click on the Registration, Fees & Assessment tab and select UView in the menu list.

Emails from UCD

The University uses email as an official means of communication with students and provides a UCD Connect email to each student for this purpose.

What you need to know

In addition to the UCD Connect email, communications will also be sent to the personal email account for all students who have provided a non-UCD Connect account.

What you need to do

Log into SISWeb and click on My Registration. Look for the My Profile link and check that your Email Preferences are up to date. If you don't want UCD to use your personal email address, you can change the setting.

Your UCD Connect email address remains the main point of contact for all communications.

Campus Car Parking

Parking permits are required on campus from 17 January until 14 May 2022 (inclusive). To apply for a parking permit go to the UCD Estate Services website.

Limited hourly paid parking is available in designated car parks and charges apply from 8am to 5pm, Monday to Friday (excluding bank holidays) 52 weeks a year.
