Complete your Registration

Your registration is your responsibility. Online registration is open for you to confirm registration if you haven't already. You can also complete personal details, upload your student card photo and pay fees if necessary.

How to Confirm Registration

- To access **online registration**, go to www.ucd.ie/connect and click on the **SISWeb** icon

When looking for a particular online service in [UCD Connect](#) for the first time, go to the **Show me** box and select **Student Applications** to narrow the search. Once you click on the appropriate icon, it will appear in the **My Recent Applications** list at the top of the page

- Enter your student **UCD Connect username and password**
- Click on the **My Registration** button and **confirm your registration** for 2022/23 if asked.
- Please confirm your registration as soon as possible

[Reactivate/Get a Student Card \(UCARD\)](#)

Your UCARD is your official identification card for the duration of your programme in UCD.

If you are a **continuing student**, once you have confirmed registration for the current academic year, your student card will be valid for 2022/23. If you need a new student card, contact the [UCARD Bureau](#).

If you are a **new student**, you must confirm your registration and upload a photo so the [UCARD Bureau](#) can print your UCARD.

[View your student record \(UView\)](#)

UView allows you to check information such as your Programme history, contact information, module registration, GPA and grades.

You can view your student record in SISWeb at any point. Do this by logging into SISWeb using your UCD student number and password. Click on the Registration, Fees & Assessment tab and select UView in the menu list.

[Emails from UCD](#)

The University uses email as an official means of communication with students and provides a UCD Connect email to each student for this purpose.

What you need to know

In addition to the UCD Connect email, communications will also be sent to the personal email address of students who have provided one.

What you need to do

- Log into **SISWeb** and click on **My Registration**
- Look for the **My Profile** link and check that your **Email Preferences** are up to date
- If you don't want UCD to use your personal email address, you can change the setting to have emails sent only to your UCD Connect address
