Complete your Registration

Your registration is your responsibility. Online registration is open for you to confirm registration if you haven't already. You can also complete personal details, upload your student card photo and pay fees if necessary.

Confirm Registration

• To access **online registration**, go to <u>www.ucd.ie/connect</u> and click on the **SISWeb** icon.

Note: When looking for a particular online service in <u>UCD</u>

<u>Connect</u> for the first time, go to the **Show me** box and select **Student Applications** to narrow the search. Once you click on the appropriate icon, it will appear in the **My Recent Applications** list at the top of the page.

- Enter your student **UCD Connect username and password**.
- Click on the My Registration button to confirm your registration for 2024/25 and begin online registration.

Reactivate/Get your UCARD

Your UCARD is your official identification card for the duration of your programme in UCD.

If you are a **continuing student**, once you have confirmed registration for the current academic year, your student card will be valid for 2024/25. If you need a new student card, contact the <u>UCARD</u> Bureau.

If you are a **new student**, you must confirm your registration and upload a photo so the <u>UCARD</u> <u>Bureau</u> can print your UCARD.

View your student record (UView)

UView allows you to check information such as your Programme history, contact information, module registration, GPA and grades.

You can view your student record in SISWeb at any point. Do this by logging into SISWeb using your UCD student number and password. Click on the Registration, Fees & Assessment tab and select UView in the menu list.

Paying Your Fees

Check the <u>fee payment dates and what you need to pay</u> for 2024/25. The first fee payment deadline will be Sunday, 11 May 2025.

Online payments can be made through your <u>SISWeb</u> account. <u>Other payment options</u> are also available.

Check your fee account regularly to ensure that you have met your fee payment requirements.

Emails from UCD

The University uses email as an official means of communication with students and provides a UCD Connect email to each student for this purpose.

What you need to know

Your UCD Connect email address is the main point of contact for all communications. However, communications will also be sent to the your personal email address if you have provided one.

What you need to do

- Log into SISWeb and click on My Registration.
- Look for the My Profile link and check that your Email Preferences are up to date.
- If you don't want UCD to use your personal email address, you can change the setting to have emails sent only to your UCD Connect address.
