Complete your Registration

Your registration is your responsibility. It is very important that you get it right to ensure that you have access to your modules in Brightspace and that your timetable is correct.

Online registration will close at 5 pm on Friday, 07 October 2022*.

To avoid a registration reactivation charge of €250, please make sure you have confirmed your registration by that date. The Privacy & Security screen (SISWeb) will indicate if you

have confirmed registration.

*Please note that online registration closed on Friday, 23 September for Stage 1 Graduate Entry programmes.

Make sure you <u>register to enough Core and option credits</u> and **drop any extra modules** you are not planning to take. The 'Free Fees' scheme will only cover you for the standard number of credits (normally 60 credits per stage).

After Friday, 07 October, ask your <u>College or School Office</u> to make any changes to Autumn Trimester modules.

If you drop an Autumn Trimester module after Friday, 11 November 2022, you will have to pay fees for that module.

In **January 2023 you can choose your Spring Trimester Elective** (if required) and review your other Spring Trimester modules. Keep an eye on the <u>key dates page</u> for updates.

View your student record (UView)

UView allows you to check information such as your Programme history, contact information, module registration, GPA and grades.

You can view your student record in SISWeb at any point. Do this by logging into SISWeb using your UCD student number and password. Click on the Registration, Fees & Assessment tab and select UView in the menu list.

Paying Your Fees

The Government of Ireland has announced a <u>cost of living package for third-level students</u> as part of Budget 2023. This includes a once-off €1000 reduction of the Student Contribution Charge for eligible students. The reduction will apply if you meet all of the following criteria:

- Full-Time Undergraduate
- Free Fees Eligible
- Registered for 2022/23 academic year
- Registered to a normal credit load (a pro-rata reduction will apply if you are registered to fewer or more credits than this - see examples)

Check the fee payment dates and what you need to pay for 2022/23.

Online payments can be made through your <u>SISWeb</u> account. <u>Other payment options</u> are also available.

Fees for **undergraduate students** will be charged on a modular basis. This means that as you select or drop modules, your fee charges will change accordingly. Check your fee account on a regular basis to ensure that you have met your fee payment requirements.

Emails from UCD

The University uses email as an official means of communication with students and provides a UCD Connect email to each student for this purpose.

What you need to know

In addition to the UCD Connect email, communications will also be sent to the personal email account for all students who have provided a non-UCD Connect account.

What you need to do

Log into SISWeb and click on My Registration. Look for the My Profile link and check that your Email Preferences are up to date. If you don't want UCD to use your personal email address, you can change the setting.

Your UCD Connect email address remains the main point of contact for all communications.

Campus Car Parking

Parking permits are required on campus from Monday, 12 September until Thursday, 22 December 2022 (inclusive) and Monday, 16 January until Friday, 19 May 2023 (inclusive). To apply for a parking permit go to the <u>UCD Estate Services website</u>.

Limited hourly paid parking is available in designated car parks and charges apply from 8 am to 5 pm, Monday to Friday (excluding bank holidays) 52 weeks a year.
