[Complete your Registration](#)

Your registration is your responsibility. It is very important that you get it right to ensure that you have access to your modules in Brightspace and that your timetable is correct.

Online registration will close at 5pm on Friday, 8 October 2021. To avoid a registration reactivation charge of €250, please make sure you have completed your registration, including repeats/resits (if needed), by that date. The Privacy and Security Screen in SISWeb will indicate if you have confirmed registration.

Make sure you [register to enough credits](#) and **drop any extra modules** you are not planning to take. The 'Free Fees' scheme will only cover you for the standard amount of credits (normally 60 credits per stage).

After 8 October, ask your [College or School Office](#) to make any changes to Autumn Trimester modules.

If you drop an Autumn Trimester module after 12 November 2021, you will have to pay fees for that module.

You will have an opportunity in January 2022 to review your Spring Trimester modules. Keep an eye on the [key dates page](#) for updates.

You can view your student record in SISWeb at any point. Do this by logging into SISWeb using your UCD student number and password. Click on the Registration, Fees & Assessment tab and select UView in the menu list.

Check the [fee payment dates and what you need to pay](#) for 2021/22. The first fee payment deadline will be 26 September 2021.

Online payments can be made through your [SISWeb](#) account. [Other payment options](#) are also available.

Fees for **undergraduate students** will be charged on a modular basis. This means that as you select or drop modules, your fee charges will change accordingly. Check your fee account on a regular basis to ensure that you have met your fee payment requirements.

Log into SISWeb and click on My Registration. Look for the My Profile link and check that your Email Preferences are up to date. If you don't want UCD to use your personal email address, you can change the setting.
