Your registration is your responsibility. It is very important that you get it right to ensure that you have access to your modules in Brightspace and that your timetable is correct.

Online registration is open for you to **confirm registration**, complete personal details, upload your student card photo and pay fees if necessary.

To access **online registration**, go to www.ucd.ie/connect and click on the **SISWeb** icon.

- Enter your student **UCD Connect username and password**.
- Click on the **My Registration** button to **confirm your registration** for 2020/21 and begin online registration.
- Please confirm your registration by Sunday, 31 January 2021

If you need to **register to modules online**, you can do this via SISWeb **between Monday, 11 January and Wednesday, 3 February 2021**. Check the [key dates page](#) for details.

[Student Card \(UCARD\)](#)

Your UCARD is your official identification card for the duration of your programme in UCD.

If you are a new student, you must **confirm your registration and upload a photo** so the [UCARD Bureau](#) can print your UCARD.

If you are a continuing student, once you have confirmed registration for the current academic year, your student card will be valid for 2020/21.

[View your student record \(UView\)](#)

UView allows you to check information such as your Programme history, contact information, module registration, GPA and grades.

You can view your student record in SISWeb at any point. Do this by logging into SISWeb using your UCD student number and password. Click on the Registration, Fees & Assessment tab and select UView in the menu list.

[Paying Your Fees](#)

Check the [fee payment dates and what you need to pay](#) for 2020/21. The first fee payment deadline will be 31 January 2021.

You can make payments of up to 1,500 euros per transaction via your [SISWeb](#) account. To make a payment and view your fees balance, **log in to SISWeb, go to Registration, Fees and Assessment and then Programme Fees and Payments.** [Other payment options](#) are also available.

The University uses email as an official means of communication with students and provides a UCD Connect email to each student for this purpose.

What you need to know

In addition to the UCD Connect email, communications will also be sent to the personal email account for all students who have provided a non-UCD Connect account.

Log into SISWeb and click on My Registration. Look for the My Profile link and check that your Email Preferences are up to date. If you don't want UCD to use your personal email address, you can change the setting.
