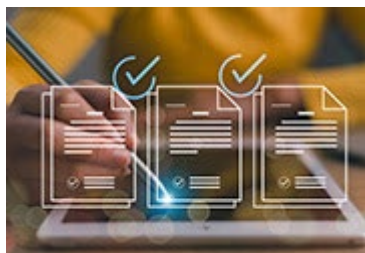
You will also find additional information below on a range of topics to assist you, whether you are completing your studies this year or returning to UCD in September.

Official Documents

You can produce your official UCD documents ([Transcripts](#), [Statements of Results](#), etc) online [via SISWeb](#).

If you send your documents to a third party, such as an employer or another university, don't forget to "enable" the documents for

verification by clicking the "enable access" button.

- For **current students or students who left before graduating**: go to Registration, Fees and Assessment > My Official Documents > Electronic Document.
- For **alumni**: go to Academic Services > Official Documents > Electronic Documents.
