- For **current students or students who left before graduating**: go to Registration, Fees and Assessment > My Official Documents > Electronic Document.

- For **alumni**: go to Academic Services > Official Documents > Electronic Documents.

If you are sending your documents to a third party, such as an employer or another university, don't forget to "enable" the documents for verification by clicking the "enable access" button.

Fees for the 2023/24 academic year have not yet been applied to continuing students' accounts.

You will see a breakdown of your 2023/24 fees in your [SISWeb](#) account when online registration opens for you. The amount of fees charged will depend on whether you have an [EU](#) or [non-EU](#) fee status.

If you still owe fees from 2022/23, it may affect the following:

- Access to examination results (including transcripts and statements)
- Registration for 2023/24
- Graduation/conferring if you are completing
- Admission to a new programme in UCD
