Online Registration 2025/26

If you haven't already, go online to **confirm registration** to your programme. To do this, log into <u>SISWeb</u> using the **Log in with UCD Connect** button. Then click on **My Registration**.

Check your your UCD Connect email for your Registration Start Time.

Your Start Time is open-ended so you can begin your registration any time from the date/time confirmed in the email.

Fees Information

Check the <u>fee payment dates and what you need to pay</u> for 2025/26. The first fee payment deadline will be Sunday, 07 September 2025.

Online payments can be made through your <u>SISWeb</u> account. <u>Other payment options</u> are also available.

Fees for **undergraduate students** will be charged on a modular basis. This means that as you select or drop modules, your fee charges will change accordingly. Check your fee account regularly to ensure that you have met your fee payment requirements.

Student Card (UCARD)

Your UCARD is your official identification card for the duration of your programme in UCD.

You must **confirm your registration and upload a photo** so the <u>UCARD Bureau</u> can print your UCARD.

Emails From UCD

The University uses email as an official means of communication with students and provides a UCD Connect email to each student for this purpose.

What you need to know

In addition to the UCD Connect email, communications will also be sent to the personal email account for all students who have provided a non-UCD Connect account.

What you need to do

Log into SISWeb and click on My Registration. Look for the My Profile link and check that your Email Preferences are up to date. If you don't want UCD to use your personal email address, you can change the setting.
