# UCD Connect

The information below will explain how to access online services such as email and online registration through UCD Connect.

### What is UCD Connect?

<u>UCD Connect</u> provides access to online services such as your official UCD student email account, Google calendar and Brightspace. You can also access online registration, via the SISWeb icon, where you must confirm your registration for the academic year.

When looking for a particular online service in <u>UCD Connect</u> for the first time, go to the **Show me** box and select **Student Applications** to narrow the search.

Once you click on the appropriate icon, it will appear in the My Recent Applications list at the top of the page.

You will need to use your student UCD Connect username and password to access these services.

If you have any queries about your UCD Connect login details or your email account, please contact the IT Support Hub for assistance.

 If you have not logged into SISWeb (or Online Applications) before, your password is your date of birth (in the format ddmmyy)

Your personalised UCD Connect email address will be used for official UCD correspondence so please make sure that you check it regularly.

## How do I access SISWeb?

- Go to www.ucd.ie/connect and click on the SISWeb icon
- Click on the Log in with UCD Connect button
- Enter your student UCD Connect username and password (see information above)

## How do I confirm my Registration?

- To access online registration, go to www.ucd.ie/connect and click on the SISWeb icon
- Click on Log in with UCD Connect and enter your student UCD Connect username and password
- Click on the My Registration button to confirm your registration for 2023/24 and begin online registration
- You will be given a Registration Start Time for your module registration and the details will be sent to your UCD Connect email • A step-by-step guide to online registration is available on the <u>Current Students website</u>
