New Academic Regulations



There are new Academic Regulations coming into effect for 2019/20. Two important changes are:

1. From the academic year 2019/20 onwards you will be able to progress carrying 10 credits from the **immediately preceding Stage** only. This means that all other Stages must be completed in full before you progress.
2. From the academic year 2019/20, resits will count towards your credit limit. You will be limited to a **maximum of 40 credits in a semester**, including resits.

Online Registration

If you are are a Stage 2+ Undergraduate student, you will need to go online and book the time your module registration will start in August. Go to [Key Dates](#) and search for Start Time to find out when you need to do this. [Read more about Start Times](#).

If you are a Stage 1 Undergraduate, Graduate Taught, Occasional and Undergraduate Certificate and Diploma student, you will have a Start Time allocated to you. Keep an eye on your UCD Connect email for the details.

Graduate Research students do not need to book a Start Time.

Paying your fees
