

# School of Chemistry Policy On Prescription Lenses Safety Glasses

## **Prescription Lenses Safety Glasses:**

For researchers who require prescription lenses, standard prescription lenses are **not** suitable as safety glasses and there are inherent risks involved in wearing contact lenses.

Over-glasses are available from Chemistry Stores which fit over most prescription glasses.

Prescription lenses safety glasses are a good option for most researchers who require prescription lenses. They are available from the UCD preferred optician in Blackrock, Jennifer Murphy.

## Full Time Staff:

The School will pay for prescription lenses safety glasses; please contact the School Office with the appended form filled out.

Full-time staff are also entitled to one eye test per year; please contact the School office for details.

## Post-Graduates and Post-Doctoral Researchers:

Prescription lenses safety glasses may be charged to a research account; please contact your supervisor for approval and bring the appended form to the School office.
