MSc in OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH Upgrade option for doctors who hold LFOM or MFOM, RCPI

Physicians who have already been awarded with the Licentiate or Membership of the Faculty of Occupational Medicine, Royal College of Physicians of Ireland, can now apply for the MSc in Occupational Health as an upgrade option, with approval for prior learning.

The upgrade option would be taken part time over one academic year.

Assessment of Candidates
Each physician applying for approval for prior learning will be assessed on an individual basis.

Modules to be undertaken leading to the MSc degree:

a) Those doctors who hold the LFOM or MFOM following completion of the UCD Higher Diploma in Occupational Health will undertake the 30 credit Thesis module. They will have exemption from the taught modules for the previous learning undertaken in UCD.

- b) Those doctors who hold the LFOM or MFOM but did not undertake the Higher Diploma in Occupational Health in UCD will undertake 50 credits. This will comprise
 - 1) 30 credit Thesis Module
 - 2) 10 credit Research Methods module
 - 10 credit essay on aspect of clinical practice of occupational medicine
