Transport

How to get to UCD from the airport

At the airport take the *Aircoach* bus service and take the line that goes to Leopardstown. This line has a stop at UCD. Depending on the time of day and traffic it can take anything between 45 and 90 minutes to get there (the airport is in the far north of Dublin, our campus is in the south of the city centre). If your hotel is in the city centre, you can also use the Aircoach line heading for Ballsbridge, the *Dublin Bus* no. 16, or the *Airlink* bus no. 747.

Transportation between the city centre and UCD

If you are staying in the city centre you can take the Dublin Bus no. 46A (towards Dun Laoghaire) or no. 145 (towards Ballywaltrim) to UCD. These busses stop on the N11 near the main entrance of UCD. Dublin Bus no. 39A (towards UCD Belfield) has its final stop on the campus. More information about the Dublin Bus time tables can be found on www.dublinbus.ie. You will need exact change to pay for your bus fare. A single trip from the city centre to UCD typically costs €2.70.
