















### Intensive Programme (IP) (September) - 5 ECTS credits

Location: Rotating among the different universities of the Network

A 10-day initial inter-university joint course that presents a wide range of humanitarian action issues by differerent specialists from the field and academia. For the forthcoming year the IP will take place in Warsaw at Universytet Warszawski (*hiperlink to http://www.noha.pl*)

# Core Course (September - January) - 25 ECTS credits

#### Location: Home University

All students during the first semester at Home University will undertake 5 modules (Geoplolitics, Anthropology, International Law, Management and Public Health).

# Orientation Period (February - June) - 30 credits

Location: Any of the NOHA Universities

Upon successful completion of the Core Course at home universities students may choose optional courses at one of the Network Universities during the second semester. The selection is done in accordance with the mobility policy scheme of the NOHA Programme.

#### Research and Intership (June - November/December)

Location: Home University / Network University

#### International Organisation/Third Country

Students are encouraged to carry out interships in local, regional, and international organisations working in the area of humanitarian action, such as the Red Cross, CARE or the European Commission's DG for Humanitarian Aid (ECHO). Organistion of internship is students' own responsibility.

After taking the second semester abroad in a second semester European University a number of European students (30) can take part in a joint research project and spend the first three months of the third semester in a NOHA partner univers ity with a European Commission grant within the Erasmus Mundus Pertnership framework.

NOHA programme finishes at the end of November for those students who are not involved in any internships or partnership programmes.
