



Articles of Agreement,

Indented, Made, Concluded, and Agreed upon, this Date.
Twenty-First Day of January, in the Year of our Lord
One Thousand, Seven Hundred and Ninety-Three;

Recites that they had agreed to form themselves into a Company for erecting a new Coffee-House, and other Buildings.

Whereas, the said several Parties to these Presents have agreed to associate and form themselves into a Company for building and erecting a New Coffee-House, with Shops and other Apartments thereunto belonging, fronting to *Coffee-Street* in the said City of *Cork*, and adjoining to the *Exchange* of said City.

And

And Also Three Dwelling Houses to the rear of said Coffee-House, fronting to Court-Lane in said City of Cork; for which purpose they the said Parties have subscribed the Capital or principal Sum of Three Thousand Five Hundred Pounds *sterling*, in One Hundred and Forty Shares, of Twenty-five Pounds *sterl.* And have subscribed a Capital of 3,500l. in 140 Shares for the purpose. each, the benefit and advantage arising from such Shares to be applied, disposed of, and regulated in the manner herein after mentioned.

And Whereas the said Parties hereto have already expended part of the said Capital Sum of Three Thousand Five Hundred Pounds in the Purchase of the Grounds whereon they intend to build and erect the said Coffee-House, Dwelling-Houses and Premises; and have agreed to expend and lay out the residue of the said Sum in the building, erecting, finishing and decorating the said intended Coffee-House, Dwelling-Houses, Shops and Premises. Part of which Sum has been expended in the purchase of Grounds. And the remainder is to be laid out on the Buildings.

And Whereas, the said Cooper Penrose, John Anderson, John Shaw, Andrew White, James Bonwell, Marcus Lynch, and Samuel McCall (Parties to these Presents) are, on the Perfection of these Presents, seized and possessed of the Grounds and Premises whereon the said Coffee-House, Shops and Dwelling-Houses are so intended to be erected, by Virtue of and under the several Deeds, Assignments and Leases, mentioned and recited in a certain Indented Deed, bearing equal Date with these Presents, subject nevertheless to the several yearly Head Rents payable thereout, amounting in the whole to the yearly Sum of

And Whereas it hath been agreed upon, by and between the said Parties to these Presents, that the said Grounds and Premises are so vested in the said Cooper Penrose, John Anderson, John Shaw, Andrew White, James Bonwell, Marcus Lynch, and Samuel McCall, in trust only, and for the benefit and advantage of all and every the said Parties hereto. And that the same Grounds and Premises, and the said Coffee-House, Shops and Dwelling-Houses, when the same shall be so built and erected thereon, and the Rents, Issues and Profits thereof, and all Benefit and Advantage thereby to be had and gotten, shall be disposed of, paid and applied, in manner and form herein after Mentioned, Expresed, and Declared. For the use of the Parties hereunto.

And Whereas, the said Parties to these Presents have, at, or before the Perfection hereof, paid into the Hands of the said James Bonwell, the full Sum of Three Thousand Five Hundred Pounds, in such Shares and Proportions as is particularly mentioned and expressed in the Schedule hereto annexed, and the Receipt of which said Sum the said James Bonwell doth hereby acknowledge.

The several Parties do therefore agree to associate themselves into a Company, under the following Agreements, viz.

James Bonwell to be Treasurer.

Now therefore these Presents WITNESS, that in pursuance and performance of the said Intention and Agreement, and in order fully and effectually to carry the same into Execution ; and for the several other Purposes and Considerations herein after contained, they the said several Parties hereto, HAVE associated and formed, and by these Presents, DO associate and form themselves into a Company and Joint-Partnership, under, and subject to the several Regulations, Provisoes, Clauses, Conditions and Agreements, herein after expressed and declared, and none other : that is to say, It is hereby declared and agreed by and between the said several Parties hereto, that the said James Bonwell be and is hereby appointed Treasurer and Keeper of the Monies, Goods, Property and Effects, Deeds, Writings, Vouches and Papers of this Company and Association, for the Term herein after mentioned.

That Schedule annexed contains account of the Shares of Capital, and also of Names, Ages, &c. of the Lives nominated

It is also hereby declared and agreed, by and between the said several Parties hereto, that the said Schedule hereunto annexed, contains a true, just, and perfect Account of the several Shares of the said Sum of Three Thousand Five Hundred Pounds, by the said several Parties hereto respectively subscribed, as also the Names, Places of Abode, Occupations, Ages and Descriptions of the several Persons nominated by the said Parties hereto respectively, for whose Lives respectively, the respective Rights, Titles and Interests of the said Parties hereto, their Executors, Administrators and Assigns, into the said Ground, Coffee-House, Dwelling-Houses and Premisses, and the Rents, Issues, and Profits thereof, shall respectively continue, as herein after is expressly mentioned and appointed.

An Instrument, in nature of a Debenture, signed by a Committee of Directors, to be given to each Subscriber.

It is also hereby declared and agreed, by and between the said several Parties hereto, that an Instrument in Writing, in nature of a Debenture, signed by a Committee of the Directors herein after named, shall be delivered to each of the said Subscribers, for each and every Share by them respectively subscribed as aforesaid.

The Grounds, and Buildings to remain vested in Subscribers.

It is also hereby declared and agreed, by and between the said several Parties hereto, that the aforesaid Grounds and Premisses, whereof the said Cooper Penrose, John Anderson, John Shaw, Andrew White, James Bonwell, Marcus Lynch and Samuel McCall, are so now seized and possessed, as aforesaid ; and the said intended Coffee-House, Shops, Dwelling-Houses, and Premisses, when the same shall be erected and built thereon, and all the Right, Title, Interest, Term and Terms, therein and thereto, and the Rents, Issues, and Profits thereof, and all Benefit, Produce, and Advantage, thereby to be had and gotten, shall and will, at all Times hereafter, continue and remain vested in the said Subscribers, Parties to these Presents, their Executors, Administrators and Assigns, to, and for the following Uses, Intents, and Purposes, that

that is to say, to the Use, Intent, and Purpose, that each Subscriber hereto, To the use, that each of them shall receive a Dividend out of the Rents, for each Share subscribed. shall have, receive, and be paid yearly out of the Rents, Issues, and Profits thereof, and as his Dividend or Dividends thereof, such Sum or Sums of Money as the proportion or proportions of an Hundred and Fortieth Part thereof, for, and upon each and every Share and Shares of Twenty-Five Pounds by him subscribed as aforesaid, shall amount to the same, to be paid to such Subscriber, his Heirs and Assigns, for and during the respective natural Lives, or During the Life of his or her Nominee, and no longer. the Persons, so by him nominated for such Share or Shares respectively as aforesaid, but no longer: And from and after the Death of any Person, for ~~whose~~ Life any such Share shall so be held as aforesaid, then the said Proportion or Dividend payable thereon as aforesaid, to go and belong to such of the said Parties hereto, whose respective Nominees shall be then living, and be equally divided between them, according to their respective number of Shares, subscribed by them respectively as aforesaid.—It being the true Intent and Meaning of these Presents, and the several Parties hereto, that the Right and Title of any of the said Parties, their Executors, Administrators and Assigns, to any Share of the said Ground, Coffee-House, Dwelling-Houses, and Premises, or the Rents, Issues and Profits thereof, shall as to such Share, cease and determine, when and as soon as the Person by him so nominated as the Life for such Share, shall happen to die, and that the same shall then be applied in the manner aforesaid.

It is also hereby declared and agreed, by and between the said several Parties hereto, that the full and entire of the yearly Rents, Issues and Profits of the said intended Coffee-House, Shops, Dwelling-Houses and Premises, and all Benefit and Advantage thereby to be had and gotten (after defraying and discharging the said yearly Head Rents, and all further and other Costs, Charges and Expences, which the Company may be necessarily at, or put to, in the prosecution of the Scheme hereby established) shall once in every Year, at the Time, and in the manner herein after mentioned, be equally and fairly divided between the said Parties hereto, their Executors, Administrators, or Assigns, or between such of them whose Nominees shall be living at the time of making such yearly Dividend (but none other) according to the number of Shares, or the Share whereof the said Parties, their Executors, Administrators or Assigns, shall be then respectively Proprietors, until by course of Survivorship, three only and no more, of the said Nominees shall continue alive: AND that when and as soon as three only of the said Nominees shall continue in being and alive, then the whole and entire of the said Grounds, Coffee-House, Shops, and Premises, with their and every of their Rights, Members, and Appurtenances, And when only three Nominees shall be living, then the Grounds, Buildings, &c. shall be the sole Property of the Subscribers, whose Shares depended on such three surviving Lives; and same shall be assigned to them. and the Rents, Issues, and Profits thereof, shall from thenceforth go and belong to such one or more of the Parties to these Presents, his or their Executors, Administrators, or Assigns, as shall be the Proprietor or Proprietors, Owner or

Owners respectively, of the Shares for which the said surviving Nominees shall have been nominated and appointed: AND, the Persons in whom the said Grounds, Houses and Premises shall be then vested, as Trustees, shall immediately upon receiving due notice of such Survivorship, or within a reasonable time thereafter, convey, assign, and make over the said Grounds, Coffee-House, Dwelling-Houses, and Premises, for and during all the Estate and Term then to come and unexpired therein, and shall hand over all Deeds, Evidences and Writings, touching or concerning the Title or Possession thereof, as the said Trustees shall be then possessed of, unto such one or more of the said Parties to these Presents, their Executors, Administrators, or Assigns, as shall become entitled thereto, in manner aforesaid. AND, if it shall happen that the said Grounds, Coffee-House, Dwelling-Houses and Premises, shall, by such right of Survivorship, become vested in, and the Property of, any two or more of the said Parties to these Presents, their Executors, Administrators, or Assigns, and that any

And any one of them may require a Partition.

one of the said Parties, who shall thereupon become entitled to one or two-third part or parts thereof, his Executors, Administrators, or Assigns, shall be minded and desirous to come to a Partition or Division of the said Grounds, Houses and Premises, then and in that case, the others or other of the said Parties to these Presents, their, his, or her Executors, Administrators, or Assigns, who shall be the Proprietors or Proprietor of the remaining Surviving Shares or Share, shall, at the request of the Person or Persons so minded and desirous, and at their mutual Costs, Charges and Expences, come to, and make such Partition and Division, and make perfect, and execute all such good and sufficient Deed and Deeds, and other Assurances in the Law, as Council shall advise to be requisite and necessary, for fully and effectually carrying such Partition and Division into Execution, and for settling and assuring unto such of the said Parties to these Presents, their Executors, Administrators, or Assigns, who shall so become entitled to the said Grounds, Coffee-House, and Premises, their respective Shares and Proportions thereof, according to the number of Surviving Shares, of which they shall be so respectively Proprietors.

Cooper Penrose, John Anderson, John Shaw, Andrew White, James Bonwell, Marcus Lynch, and Samuel McCall, appointed Directors, who with the Treasurer, are to continue in Office until others are elected.

It is also hereby declared and agreed, by and between the said several Parties hereto, that the said Cooper Penrose, John Anderson, John Shaw, Andrew White, James Bonwell, Marcus Lynch, and Samuel McCall, be and are hereby appointed Directors and Managers of the Funds, Effects and Property of this Society; and that they the said Directors, with the Treasurer herein before appointed, shall continue in Office for one Year, from the First Day of October next, and until a new Treasurer and Directors shall be elected and chosen at a General Meeting, as herein after is directed.

Thomas Chatterton appointed Clerk, and to continue till his death, resignation, or removal by general meeting of the Society.

It is also hereby declared and agreed, by and between the said several Parties hereto, that the said Thomas Chatterton be, and is hereby appointed Clerk

Clerk to this Company or Society, in which Office he shall continue until the death or resignation of him the said Thomas Chatterton, or until he shall be removed by a General Meeting of the said Company or Society; and that the said Thomas Chatterton shall receive a yearly Sallary of Twenty-Two Pounds At a Sallary of 20 Guineas a Year. Fifteen Shillings for his trouble in executing said Office, provided that he shall give Five Hundred Pounds Security for the due and faithful Discharge thereof. To give 500l. Security for his faithful discharge of the office.

It is also hereby declared and agreed, by and between the said several Parties hereto, that the said seven Directors herein before named, or their Successors, or any Three or more of them, with or without the Treasurer, shall form and be a Committee of this Society, and shall have full and entire power and authority to do, transact, perform, regulate, manage and direct all Matters and Things whatsoever, touching or in anywise concerning this Company or Society, or the Monies, Goods, Premisses, Effects or Property thereof, or the Receipts or Expenditures thereof; provided that no Act of theirs shall or do alter or vary the Rights of the said several Subscribers to their respective Shares and Dividends, upon the several Sums by them respectively subscribed as aforesaid, and to the benefit of Survivorship, as aforesaid: that the said Committee shall from Time to Time have full power and authority, by Deed or Deeds in Writing, under their Hands and Seals, to Demise, Lease, or Let the said Coffee-House, Dwelling-Houses and Premisses, or such Part or Parts thereof as they shall think proper, to such Person or Persons, for such Term or Terms, and at and under such yearly Rent or Rents, as the said Committee shall in their Discretion think fit; (provided the same be made at the best yearly improved Rent that may or can be reasonably had for the same, from good and solvent Tenants.) And that the said Directors, or a Committee of them, shall meet And that Directors, or a Committee of them, shall meet once a Quarter and oftner if summoned. once in every Quarter of a Year at the least, and oftner if summoned by the Treasurer or Clerk.

It is also hereby declared and agreed, by and between the said several Parties hereto, that a General Meeting of this Company or Society shall be held General Meeting to be held on every first Monday in October, who shall elect a Chairman. on the First Monday in the Month of October in every Year, at which General Meeting a Chairman shall be chosen by a majority of Votes of the Subscribers present, to preside; and thereupon the names of the then Directors shall be separately put into a Hat, and two of them shall be drawn thereout, and the Persons whose Names shall be so drawn thereout, shall from thenceforth cease to be Directors; and two others (being Subscribers) shall thereupon be chosen and elected by a majority of Votes, to serve as Directors in the place and stead of the Persons so ceasing as aforesaid; so as that not more than Five of the said Directors shall continue in said Office, from and after the First Monday in October in every Year; notwithstanding that the full number of Seven Directors shall be constantly continued and kept up.

Treasurer continued or removed, at will of the Meeting.

It is also hereby declared and agreed, by and between the said several Parties hereto, that at the same General Meeting, the then Treasurer shall be continued in his Office, or removed therefrom; and a new one (being a Member of this Society) chosen in his room, as the majority of Subscribers present shall determine and agree.

Chairman to have a casting Vote.

It is also hereby declared and agreed, by and between the said several Parties hereto, that at all such Elections, or at any other General Meeting of this Society, the Chairman chosen to preside thereat, shall have a Vote as a Subscriber, upon any Question or Resolution relative to this Company or Society; and that where the Votes of the Members present shall in any of such occasions happen to be equal, then and as often as it shall so happen, the Chairman chosen to preside at such Meeting, shall have a casting Vote, over and besides the Vote he shall have given as a Subscriber.

Treasurer or Clerk may call other General Meetings, giving ten days notice in Cork News-Papers.

It is also hereby declared and agreed, by and between the said several Parties hereto, that besides the Annual General Meeting, herein before appointed, a Committee of the Directors, the Treasurer or Clerk, may call and convene one or more other General Meeting or Meetings at such times as they or he shall think proper, giving full Ten Days previous Notice of such General Meeting in the *Cork News-Papers*.

Clerk to be elected at next General Meeting after a vacancy, and like Security to be given, and Salary ascertained.

It is also hereby declared and agreed, by and between the said several Parties hereto, that at the next General Meeting to be held after any Vacancy shall happen in the Office of Clerk, such General Meeting, whether Annual or otherwise, shall elect and chose a Person to fill the said Office of Clerk, and shall at the same Time ascertain and fix the yearly Salary to be paid such new elected Clerk, such Clerk giving such Security as herein before appointed to be given by the said Thomas Chatterton.

Duty of the Clerk.

It is hereby further declared and agreed, by and between the said several Parties hereto, that the Clerk shall attend all Meetings of the Subscribers, and also all Meetings of the Directors or a Committee of them, and shall enter the Proceedings of such Meetings in a Book, to be by him kept for that purpose:—that he shall keep an Account of all Rents, Monies, Effects and Property, which shall or may from Time to Time be received for the use and benefit of this Society, and of all Sum and Sums of Money, Salaries, Costs and Expenses advanced, laid out, or paid, for or on account thereof:—that he shall, if required, assist the Treasurer in such Receipts and Expenditures, and shall regularly and fairly account with him the said Treasurer, for any Sum or Sums he shall happen to receive.—**It is also** hereby declared and agreed, by the said several Parties hereto, that the Clerk shall also keep one or more Book or Books containing

taing the Names of the Subscribers, and the Sums by each subscribed, and the Share or Shares to which each Subscriber is entitled, as also the Names, Ages, and Places of Abode of the Nominees for such Shares respectively; and the Names, Places of Abode, Additions, Occupations and other Descriptions of their Parents (whether Living or Dead) as shall best ascertain the Persons, and identity of such Nominees respectively.

It is also hereby declared and agreed, by the said several Parties hereto, Power to Subscriber to assign or devise Share. that it shall and may be lawful for any Subscriber or Subscribers, his, her, or their Executors, Administrators or Assigns, at any Time or Times, during the Life or Lives of his, her, or their Nominee or Nominees, by Writing under his, her, or their Hand and Seal, or by his, her, or their last Will or Wills in Writing, to Assign or Devise his, her, or their Share or Shares, of and in the said Grounds, Houses and Premisses, and the Rents, Issues and Profits thereof, to any Person or Persons, for and during the Life or Lives of such Nominee or Nominees respectively, PROVIDED that a Minit or Memorandum A Memorandum thereof to be entered in a Book by the Clerk, within three months. of such Assignment or Devise be entered in a Book to be kept by the Clerk for that purpose, within Three Calender Months from the Date of such Assignment, (if assigned) or from the Death of the Persons devising the same (if bequeathed by Will) and that such Assignment, Probate of the Will, or Letters of Administration as the Case may be, shall be produced to the Committee of Directors. And the assignment, probate or administration, produced to the Committee. AND PROVIDED FURTHER, that an Affidavit of the Execution of such Assignment (if transferred by Deed) sworn before some Magistrate, shall be filed with the Clerk. 


