The UCD in the Community Ambassador Programme is a programme aimed at raising awareness of the UCD in the Community (UCDIC) Initiative. We are looking for **six motivated students from year 2 onwards** with enthusiasm and commitment to promoting the work of UCD in the Community within the UCD campus and the wider community. This is an excellent opportunity to gain valuable paid experience, develop your skills and build our engagement.

Benefits of being a UCD in the Community Ambassador

This programme is designed to develop and enhance student skills whilst making a valuable contribution to UCD and its wider community.

- This will be a paid role with opportunities to get involved in some voluntary roles occasionally

Role & Responsibilities

- Planning, organising and executing UCD in the Community Flagship events both online and in person. E.g. Hopefest, UCD Volunteer Day, Annual Dublin Simon Appeal, Volunteer Awards
- Promote, attend, and assist with UCDIC events such as flagship annual events, volunteer fairs, lecture addresses and promotion of student volunteering & its platform StudentVolunteer.ie
- Support and promote the UCD in the Community Student Volunteering Awards
- Create social media content, including video content for Instagram, and YouTube
- Create visual designs that aid the promotion of any of the above mentioned (e.g. using Canva)

Skills & Requirements

- Social media savvy with an interest in further developing our Digital Marketing Strategy
- Approachable and enthusiastic - the ability to engage students on their own initiative and garner interest towards StudentVolunteer.ie
- Excellent customer service (or student engagement) skills
- Interest in community engagement and knowledge of UCD in the Community
- This job has a low time commitment, hours will vary month to month (there will be opportunities to take on more hours as necessary).
- Training will be provided
