Stage 1 Veterinary Nursing Students can order a set of equipment through your class rep and the Vet Nursing Administrator. Details will be given at Orientation.

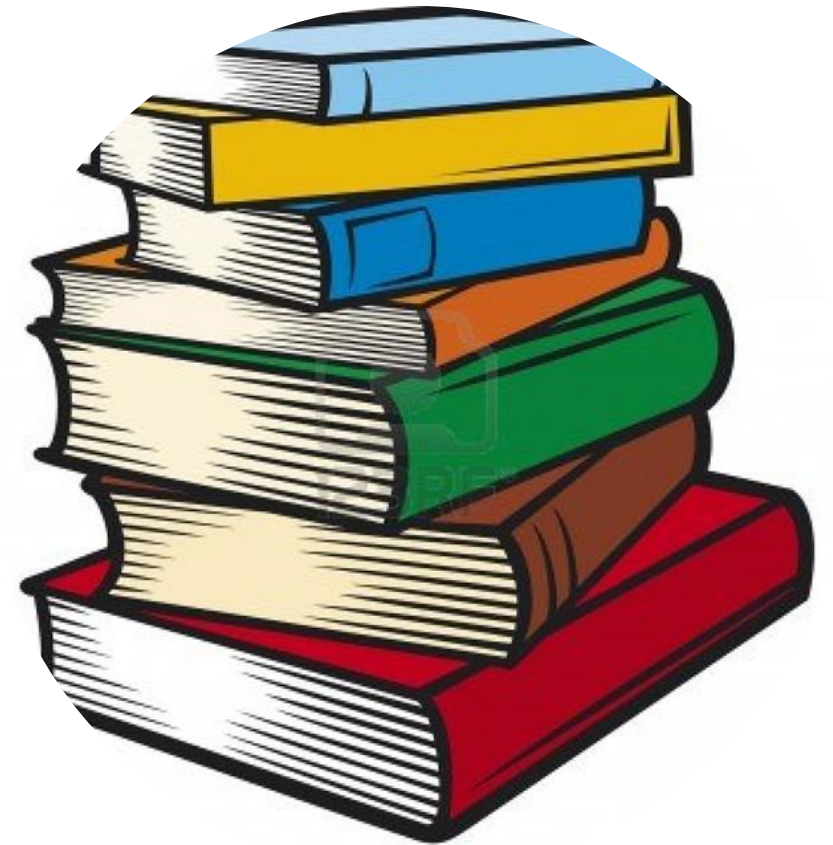

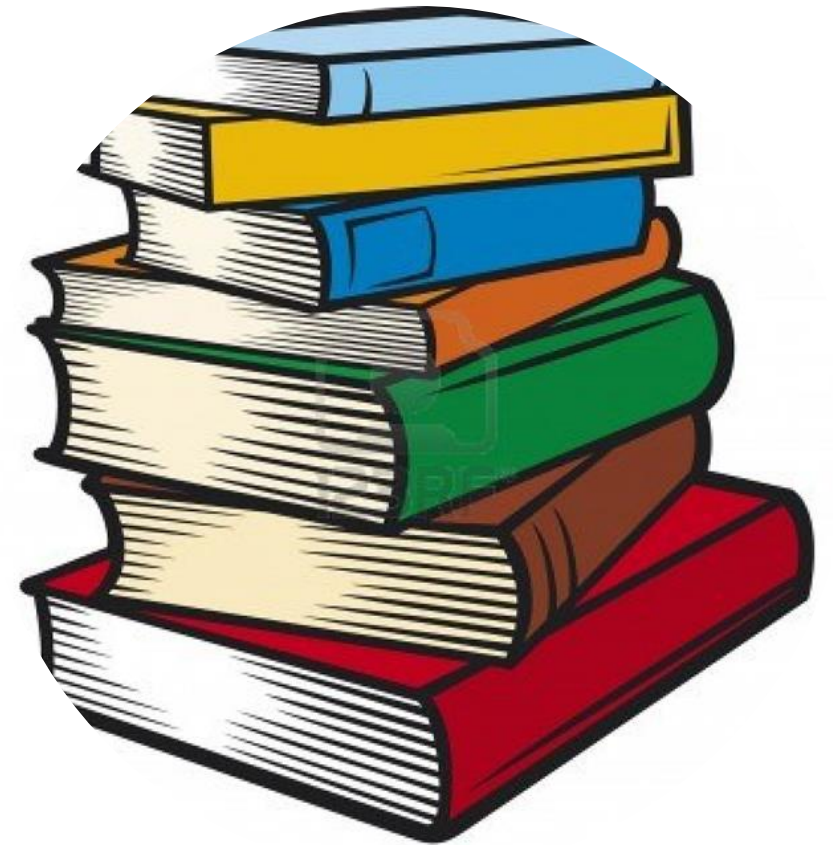

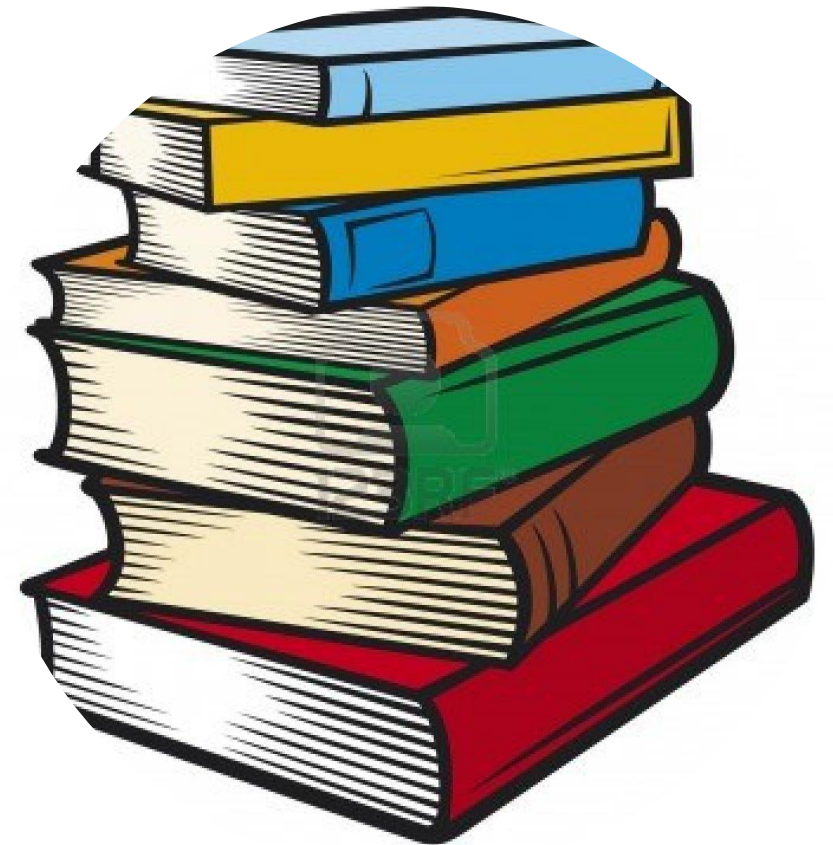
