### Position Summary:

The Section of Equine Clinical Studies, Diagnostic Imaging and Anaesthesia of the School of Veterinary Medicine in UCD has an exciting opportunity for a full-time equine veterinarian to join the UCD Veterinary Hospital team. This individual will support the continued growth of the equine field service. The appointment is subject to the qualifications and experience of the candidates.

The UCD Veterinary Hospital has a full referral hospital for large and small animals with state of the art equipment including CT and MRI. The Equine Field Service is ambulatory and offers on-site care to horses at their stable or yard in South Dublin and Wicklow. Its services include primary care from routine to lameness examinations, dentistry, reproductive services and medical investigation. There is direct access to more specialist services in UCD Veterinary Hospital.

Applicants must hold a degree in veterinary medicine registerable with the Veterinary Council of Ireland (see [www.vci.ie](http://www.vci.ie)). The successful candidate will contribute effectively to the section and the UCD Veterinary Hospital and will participate in undergraduate (clinical) teaching.

### Principal Duties and Responsibilities:

- Work as an equine clinician in the Equine Field Service.
- Contribute, on a shared basis, to the out-of-hours roster.
- Provide clinical teaching to (under)graduate veterinary and veterinary nursing students.
- To participate in formal student assessment.
- To contribute, if necessary, to Committees as a member of the Section and School to the successful functioning of the organisation.
- To ensure compliance with all aspects of relevant legislation and Health & Safety protocols.
- To undertake any other reasonable duties as required by Line Management.
