Important information when submitting carcasses

- Notification must be received in advance that a carcass is being submitted (contact details above).
- It is preferable to refrigerate rather than freeze bodies. Bodies should only be frozen if refrigeration is expected to be longer than 5 days.
- Report will be sent directly to named practitioner above who is responsible for notifying owner of necropsy results.
